

The Essentials of Scenario-Based E-Learning

Scenario-based e-learning, also called casebased learning or whole-task learning, offers a unique opportunity to accelerate expertise by putting the learner in the role of a worker responding to a carefully selected sequence of realistic job assignments. It is especially appropriate for helping learners build domain-specific critical thinking skills or transform dull compliance courses into engaging decision-making lessons. Welldesigned scenario-based e-learning can offer a motivational and cost-effective instructional environment. Based on her latest book, Ruth Clark will overview SBeL including guidelines for building a business-case, evidence, as well as a design and development model.
